 (Wool pillows and duvets are great for allergy sufferers because wool is anti-allergenic. Mould doesn't grow on wool and house dust mites hate wool for two reasons: they don't like the many fibres and the environment of wool is too dry for mites to thrive in so they avoid it)

- · We strongly recommend that you take out holiday insurance cover to include cancellation cover

On arrival guests will find

- Check in from 3.30 onwards, check out by 10.30 on departure. This can be flexible with prior arrangement.
- · Please contact us if you are likely to be very late arriving.
- A generally level site.
- Two free car parks close to rooms (one tarmac, one gravel).
- · One room (The Hayloft) has immediate free car parking with ample lighting.
- Movement sensitive lights in gardens and approaches to rooms.
- · Pathways around the site are high quality, level and well lit.
- Help with luggage.
- · Free wi-fi in all rooms.
- The main dining room has a ramp leading to the door.
- The garden is decked near the house and lawned with high quality pathways linking the facilities.
- Dinner can be served in the The Shack which has one step but is otherwise level with wide French doors, The Lounge with a ramp or The Party Shed with a step over the threshold.
- One room (The Hayloft) has a ramp leading to the room, with a walk in wet room and shower chair can be provided.
- Guests in all rooms have access to the gardens, where there are various seating areas.
- Three rooms (The Hideaway, Nook and Cranny) have their own private gardens.
- There is a sauna in Nook and private hot tub.
- · There is a private hot tub in the garden of Cranny.
- Hot tub on the deck is available to all guests between 6 am til 10 pm.
- Therapies must be pre-booked (book early to avoid disappointment).
- · Non smoking apart from outer decking area where ashtrays are provided.
- Fire emergency procedures are detailed in each room in the Welcome Pack. If the fire alarm sounds please vacate your room immediately.

- All linen is 100% cotton from The White Company / The Wool Company.
- Pillows duck down.
- · Duvet duck down or goose.
- · Cotton robes.
- Feather mattress toppers.
- We also use allergy free wool duvet and wool pillows (available on request).

Food

- · We buy fresh locally sourced seasonable produce.
- Guests staying in The Hayloft and The Hideaway have fridges. Nook and Cranny have retro SMEG fridge/freezers.
- Guests who require fridge facilities can use the fridges in the main house.

- There is a wide ramp path at the front of The Hayloft which leads to the front door.
- Ramp = 1100mm W x 4800mm L.
- Doorway is level access (1000mm).
- · Wet room doorway (1000mm).
- · Sink height (740mm).
- Toilet height (410mm).
- Bed height (680mm).
- · Grab rails in the wet room.
- · Non slip floor in the wet room.
- · Shower chair available on request.
- · Tiled floor in bedroom.
- · Beds can be made up as either super king or twin.
- · First floor adjoining twin room.
- · Dining room in the main house with ramp access.
